

# Complaints to the BBC: April 2016

The BBC answered over **16,000** complaints from the audience during April 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints about Radio 4's Don't Make Me Laugh on April 21 from listeners who felt jokes relating to the Royal Family and The Queen were inappropriate.

There were also complaints from viewers who were disappointed that Gardeners' World wasn't broadcast on April 8 due to coverage of the England v Belgium Women's Euro 2017 football qualifier.
