

Complaints to the BBC: April 2017

The BBC answered over **15,000** complaints from the audience during April 2017. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from viewers and listeners who were unhappy with a tweet sent by Laura Kuennsberg on 24th April. Some felt a reference to a 'Tory strategy' regarding Jeremy Corbyn's presence in Scotland suggested a bias against Labour and betrayed a personal viewpoint.
