

## **BBC** Complaints to the BBC: February 2017

The BBC answered over **16,000** complaints from the audience during February 2017. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from some viewers and listeners who felt there was too much coverage of The Oscars across BBC News.

We received complaints from some viewers who experienced audibility problems after watching the first episode of the new BBC One drama SS-GB.

Finally, there were complaints from some listeners about the earlier timeslot for BBC Radio 2's Sounds of the 60s on Saturday mornings.
