

# Complaints to the BBC: July 2016

The BBC answered just over **22,000** complaints from the audience during July 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from viewers unhappy with some of the half-time punditry during the Euro 2016 Wales v Belgium match.

We also received complaints from some viewers unhappy with the technical difficulties we encountered at the end of the Ride London broadcast on the 31<sup>st</sup> of July.
