

## **BBC** Complaints to the BBC: November 2016

The BBC answered nearly **18,500** complaints from the audience during November 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from viewers of the 11<sup>th</sup> November Remembrance Day Two Minute Silence on BBC One who were disappointed that a reading was not broadcast in full at the end of the silence.

We also received complaints from some viewers unhappy that Andrew Marr interviewed Marine Le Pen, leader of France's National Front political party, on Remembrance Sunday during The Andrew Marr Show.
